A Question Of Capacity

Do you feel stuck? Do you think you are unable to do what God wants you to do? Have you started something you thought God wanted you to start and now are not able to go on with it? Do you need more to be able to carry out what you started? Many people can find themselves in this kind of situation. Often it is a question of not having enough capacity to go further. To grow more you may need a higher capacity. You might be going at full capacity right now and the only way on is to increase your capacity.

How Do You Increase Your Capacity

You increase your capacity by increasing your faith. How do you increase your faith? Ask God for it. Faith comes by hearing (Romans 10:17). God will communicate with you in some way. The result will be an increase in your faith. The result of that will be an increase in your capacity. The result of that will be the ability to get unstuck and move on. That is what happened with Sarah (see the citation above). It will happen with us. Where are you stuck right now? What is God giving you that will increase your faith? Ask God to supply that new level of faith.
