But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment; whoever insults his brother will be liable to the council; and whoever says, 'You fool!' will be liable to the hell of fire. Matthew 5:22

Impossible To Do

The words of Jesus above are absolutely impossible to do on our on power. How much does it take for our anger to rise against someone? What if we are treated very poorly, or a member of our family is bullied, or worse? How soon would you call the perpetrators "fools"? Or, would you call them something worse than that? Or, would yo do something worse than that? All of that is our natural way of responding to being mistreated or attacked. In order to do what Jesus tells us to do we need to have a supernatural power working in our lives.

Naturally Supernatural

There will always be something around that sets off our anger. It takes the presence of Jesus and the power of the Holy Spirit to begin to live in the way Jesus would have us live. It takes that same power and presence to recognize that we have fallen short of what Jesus asks of us. It takes that same power and presence to seek and receive the forgiveness God has for us. Hearing the Spirit of God say to us in someway, "You are forgiven," followed by, "You are my child whom I love" is the way God begins to give us power to live the life of following Jesus. How can we put ourselves into the position to hear the voice of God say that, especially when we are angry with someone else? That is the key to living a life of discipleship.
