

Lent Is Underway

One could be that the discipline is too rigorous for where we are right now in our lives. It could be that we did not know enough about what keeping up that discipline would take. Those important things to know.

What do you imagine God will do if you fail at the discipline you have chosen? Is that the God we see in Jesus? What does Jesus want you to know about your Lenten discipline? What is Jesus telling you about who you are? Can you lean into the Spirit of God and begin to catch those answers right now? It may provide some fuel for the discipline that has stalled. It will also provide much ore than that.
