

How Has Lent Worked Out?

We are in the fifth week of Lent. Palm Sunday: The Sunday of the Passion is this coming Sunday. Our Lenten disciplines will be drawing to a close. Easter will bring us to a new season of celebration. There is one bench mark I want to keep in front of us as we look back on Lent and look forward to Easter. Do we know Jesus any better now than we did at the beginning of Lent? Have our Lenten disciplines helped us to know more of Jesus? Can we follow Him more closely than we did at the beginning of Lent?

Some Thoughts About Continuing On

Knowing Jesus is something that goes gradually, sometimes imperceptibly as we go on day by day. Here are some questions we can ask ourselves:

- 1. Do I have more desire to learn about the Bible?
- 2. Do I want to see other people blessed more than I did before?
- 3. Do I want to spend time with other people just to get to know them, and maybe even see what God is doing in their lives?
- 4. Do I find I want to hear from God more in my prayers?
- 5. Do I find I want to learn more about who Jesus is?

These are some of the ways we can have confidence we are getting to know Jesus better. Keeping up habits of blessing other people, getting to know other people better, listening to the voice of the Spirit of God, and learning of Jesus from the gospels and other books will keep us on the path of knowing Him better. We can keep these habits going beyond Lent.
